Thank you for being part of this celebration.

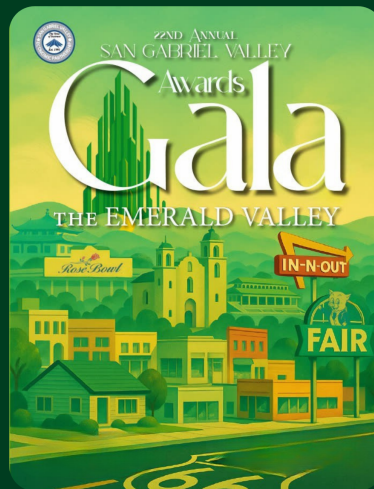

# Christina Pascucci

Christina Pascucci has had an illustrious career as a fearless journalist. From interviewing the globe's most influential spiritual and political figures to braving the perils of war zones and championing the cause of justice by exposing and changing corrupt policies, Christina's zeal for uncovering the truth knows no borders.

Her dedication led her to the front lines in Armenia to tell the stories of the civilians whose homes had been shelled in Sotk and Jermuk, and to cover the humanitarian crisis in Nagorno-Karabakh. She was honored by the city of Los Angeles for her work.

She also made the journey to Antarctica to raise awareness around environmental issues. Her passion for the environment and protecting the ocean led her to swim among hundreds of sharks to expose the dark underbelly of the shark finning industry. She journeyed to the slowly vanishing Palau to engage in discussions about climate concerns and sea-level rise with President Thomas Remengesau, who honored her with the role of Goodwill Ambassador to the nation. Among her more notable moments was an exclusive interview with the Dalai Lama.

Her professional journey has lit a fire of philanthropy within her. During an assignment, she crossed paths with a young Afghan who had fallen victim to an IED near her war-torn homeland. Christina was inspired to become actively involved with the Children of War Foundation, which made life-changing surgeries and prosthetics possible. She now serves on their board and has embarked on missions to Ukraine, Haiti, Central America, and the Middle East.

Christina's tireless advocacy extends to mental health awareness, foster youth, and unhoused families. She believes fervent support of foster youth is a key pillar to fighting homelessness, as they sadly comprise a large percentage of the homeless population. Through her decade-long involvement with the Junior League of Los Angeles, Christina advocated for these causes in Sacramento, and fought to pass bipartisan legislation to support unhoused families.

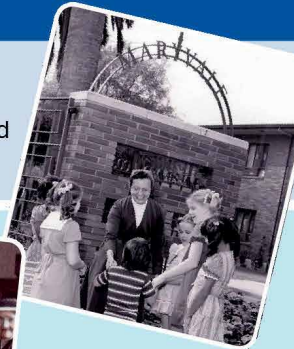

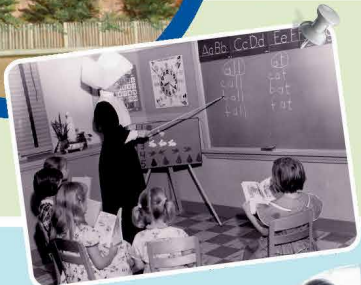

# Four More Stations Now Open

New Glendora Metro A Line Station



The Glendora to Pomona project was funded by LA County's Measures M & R, along with state funds (including SB1).



Foothill Gold Line

The Foothill Gold Line is extending LA County's Metro A Line light rail system to the cities of Glendora, San Dimas, La Verne, Pomona, Claremont and Montclair – and is being built in segments. The four-station Glendora to Pomona segment was completed on time and on budget, and opened for passenger service on September 19, 2025.

The final two-station Pomona to Montclair segment is now underway with the procurement process to hire the designer and contractor. Once the contractor is hired and construction begins, the project is expected to take about four years to build to Claremont and Montclair.

# Public Service Award

## Assemblywoman Blanca E. Rubio



Assemblywoman Blanca E. Rubio is a dedicated public servant whose work in the California State Assembly has had a lasting impact on the San Gabriel Valley. Since her election in 2016, she has championed critical issues such as domestic violence, education, and immigrant rights. Notably, she co-sponsored SB 273 to extend the statute of limitations for domestic violence victims and improve police training. Beyond legislation, Assemblywoman Rubio has been a strong community advocate, organizing initiatives like the annual Operation Gobble turkey giveaway for families in need. She has also supported early literacy programs and policies to improve outcomes for foster youth and students with disabilities. Recognized for her advocacy, she received the Public Service Award from Autism Speaks for her work on transition planning for students with autism.

# Heritage Award: 100th Anniversary

## W. K. Kellogg Arabian Horse Center Cal Poly Pomona



Established in 1925 by cereal magnate W.K. Kellogg, the Arabian Horse Ranch in Pomona has played a vital role in shaping the traditions and history of Cal Poly Pomona for a full century. In 1926, Kellogg launched his popular "Sunday Shows", which attracted large crowds and Hollywood celebrities, and the horses gained fame through film appearances. Today, the W.K. Kellogg Arabian Horse Center is home to around 70 purebred Arabian horses and remains the oldest continuous Arabian breeder in the U.S. The Center welcomes over 10,000 visitors annually and actively involves more than 100 students, including full-time stable residents and participants in programs like the Horsemanship Club and "Horses for Heroes" for veterans. A new partnership with TeachingHorse brings global leadership training to the campus, continuing Kellogg's belief that "education offers the greatest opportunity for really improving one generation over another."

When the Eaton Fire struck the foothills, the San Gabriel Valley answered with unity and care. It would be impossible to highlight all of the individuals and organizations who banded together in the wake of the tragedy, but at this year's Gala, we salute three particular San Gabriel Valley institutions that stepped forward to provide vital aid and support when needed.

Pasadena City College transformed itself into a center of compassion as students, faculty, and staff filled the campus with donations and worked tirelessly to deliver supplies to neighbors in need.

The expansive grounds of Santa Anita Park became a major hub, where hundreds of volunteers distributed food, water, and essentials to displaced families.

The Rose Bowl, serving initially also as a distribution center, soon became a vital staging ground for first responders—a place where fire crews could coordinate, regroup, and prepare for the challenges ahead.

Together, these beloved institutions turned hardship into hope, showing that recovery is more than rebuilding—it is neighbors lifting one another, and landmarks transforming into lifelines. Their response stands as a powerful reminder of the San Gabriel Valley's resilience and heart.

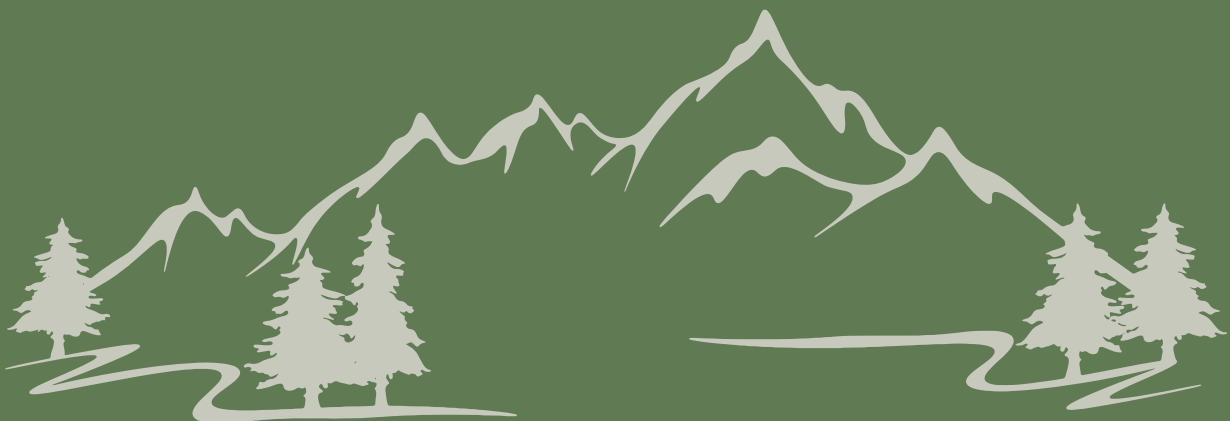

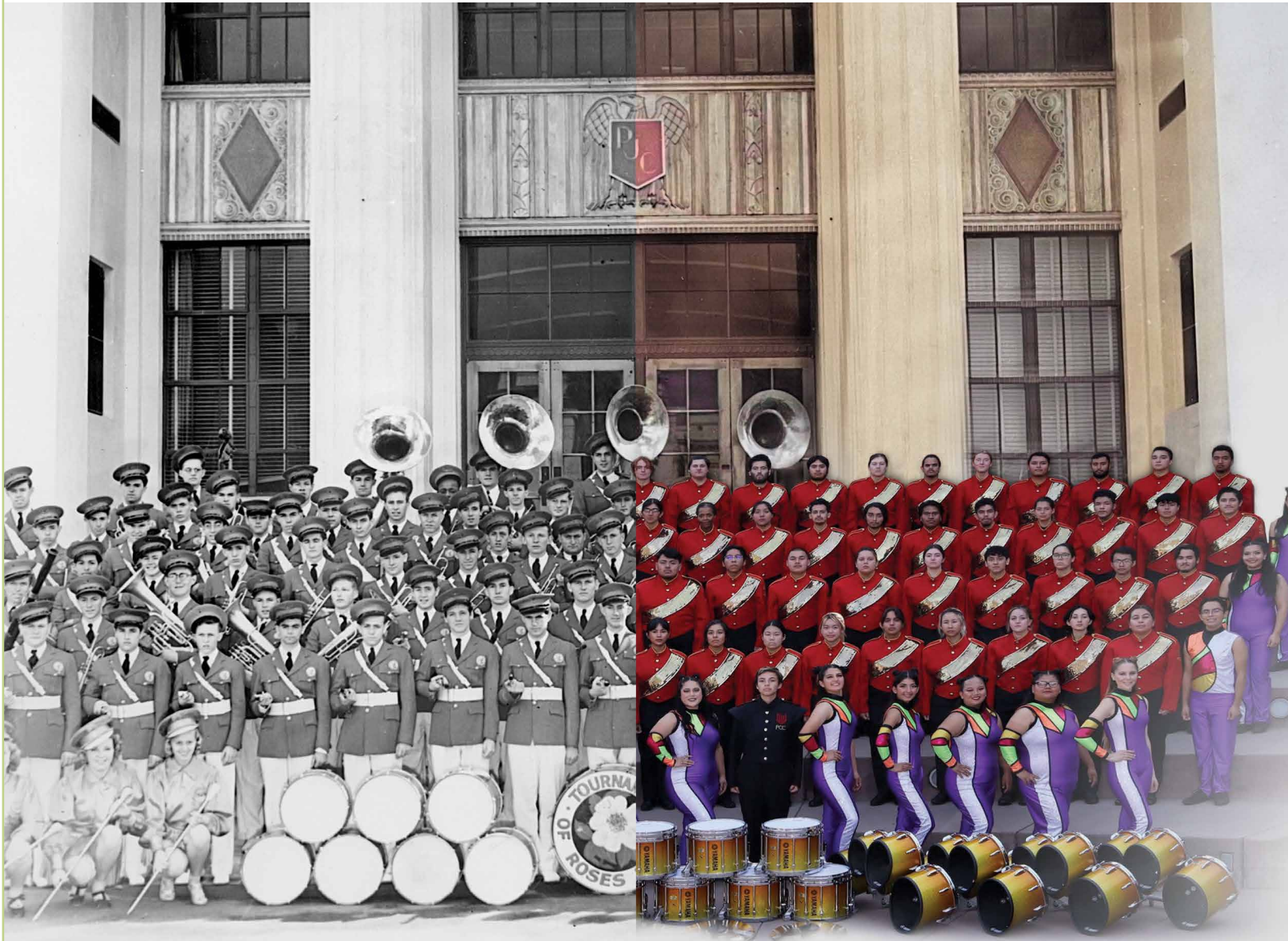

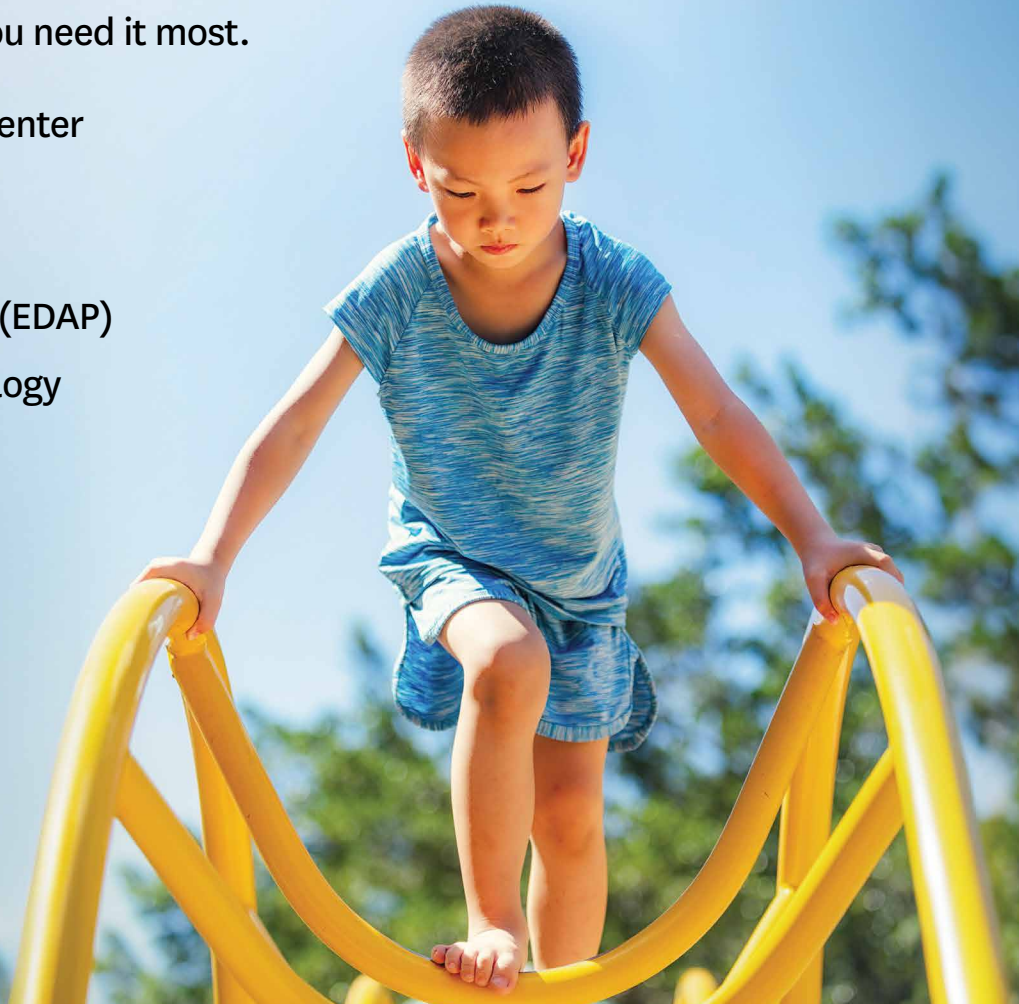
